MINUTES OF TOWN BOARD MEETING
May 8, 2017

Meeting opened at 7:00pm. Present were Chairman William Mangold, Supervisors Paul Thomsen and Bill Henningfield, Clerk Karla Hill and Treasurer Linda Skiles. 7 area residents and guests were in attendance. Mangold led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Henningfield to approve minutes of April 10th Town Board meeting, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Motion by Henningfield to approve April treasurer's report, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Motion by Henningfield to pay bills for month of April, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Licenses-Motion by Thomsen to approve temporary gathering license for St. Joes' Chicken Dinner on June 4th, seconded by Henningfield, Carried. Motion by Henningfield to approve two operator licenses, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Correspondence-Memorial Day Service at the Town Hall on May 29th at 10:00am.

St. Joes rescinded their request for street closing, no action taken.

Chapter 29 "Utilities in the Right of Way" covers most of what was presented last month for an ordinance to control communication towers. Our current ordinance does not mention "safety", so Dennis Lynch and Mark Kolczaski will work on additional wording to be added.

Clerk mentioned process to update all ordinances was under way.

There was continued discussion this month on Bridlewood Estates issues of removing gate at north entrance and bringing north roads up to Town standards. No action was taken.

Fire Department-Interested in going in on a joint fire training facility with City and Town of Burlington, Rochester and Wheatland. Recent practice fire went well. Tankers are not leaking currently.
