

TOWN OF LYONS
MINUTES OF TOWN BOARD MEETING
July 10, 2017

Meeting opened at 7:00pm. Present were Chairman William Mangold, Supervisors Paul Thomsen and Bill Henningfield, Clerk Karla Hill, and Treasurer Linda Skiles. 5 area residents and guests were in attendance. Mangold led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Henningfield to approve minutes of June 12th Town Board meeting, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Motion by Thomson to approve June treasurer's report, seconded by Henningfield, Carried.

Motion by Henningfield to pay bills for month of June, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Licenses-Motion by Henningfield to approve 8 operator licenses, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Correspondence-None

Stonegate Investments Certified Survey Map needs to go to the Planning Commission before Town Board. No action taken.

Linda Skiles, as spokesperson for "**Lyons for a Better Neighborhood**" discussed the proposal for electric service to be run to park area between North and South Railroad Streets. Electric would be used to light up Christmas and other holiday decorations, or for community events such as Street Dances or Flea Markets. Skiles had already discussed with Department of Natural Resources and Walworth County, who were in favor of the improvements. Motion by Henningfield to donate \$3000 to "Light up Lyons" for installation of electrical service, seconded by Thomsen, Carried. Henningfield stated that electric service would then be owned by Town of Lyons.

Fire Department-Received grant of \$109,000 for purchase of hoses and nozzles.

Highway Department-Most of 2017 road improvements are complete. Time Warner Cable wants to place more cable along Sheridan Springs Road. The Ivanhoe boat launch area is in need of work. 2941 Berndt Road has put their driveway coming off Cranberry Road, which was not according to permit. Clerk will write letter.
