

TOWN OF LYONS
MINUTES OF TOWN BOARD MEETING
October 9, 2017

Meeting opened at 7:00pm. Present were Chairman William Mangold, Supervisors Paul Thomsen and Bill Henningfield, Clerk Karla Hill, and Treasurer Linda Skiles. 7 area residents and guests were in attendance. Mangold led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Thomsen to approve minutes of September 11th Town Board meeting, seconded by Henningfield, Carried.

Motion by Thomsen to approve September treasurer's report, seconded by Henningfield, Carried.

Motion by Henningfield to pay bills for month of September, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Licenses-Motion by Henningfield to approve 2 operator licenses, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Correspondence-Wisconsin Town's Association will hold the Walworth County meeting at the Lyons' Town Hall on October 26th 2017. Clerk read a plea for citizen action on Senate Bills 291 and 292 having to do with taxing of "big box" stores.

Cleaners have quit cleaning and clerk believes it will cost considerably more for future services. Some discussion about costs and services.

Mark K, Baxter and Woodman updated board on Thomsen Road bridge replacement progress. Motion by Henningfield to accept **Reesman's Excavating & Grading bid of \$14,281.35** for construction of temporary access to Thomsen Road, subject to obtaining permits, seconded by Thomsen, Carried.

Joe Novak request to lease land from town of Lyons was canceled by applicant. Other more suitable locations for tower have been found.

Fire Department-Wood for bonfire will only be collected on Saturday October 21st and 28th from 7am-Noon.
Highway Department-Wanasek and Payne & Dolan have submitted bids for pavement patching on various roads in the Town.

Ordinance Enforcer-None

Sheriff- Mangold asked them to check on size of "no Left turn" sign near medical center on State Street(Old Hwy 36), seems too small. Clerk asked about Sheriff Department contributing to cost of cleaning in the future.
