Stonebeigh Real Estate, LLC. After extensive discussion and concerns from local neighbors Bill Henningfield moved to table the issue. Paul Thomsen seconded the motion. It was recommended that the owner of the property and the town consider the suggestions from the neighbors to:

- Limit venue hours to end at sunset
- Limit size of guest capacity to 100 persons
- Specify in Conditional Use Permit that temporary warning signage be placed on the road to warn of blind spots during events
- Prohibit parking on Knob road during events, especially vendor trucks.
- Town of Lyons to clear blind spot at Warren and Knob on northeast corner
